



# SUPPLIES

## TENT GEAR

- Backpacking style tent with poles and lines
- Tent Stakes
- Ground Cloth for under tent (usually piece of plastic)
- 1/8" Nylon cord - 25 feet

## COOKING GEAR

- Eating Kit
  - Spoon
  - Plate
  - Bowl
  - Cup (metal or heat resistant type)
  - Dunk bag (mesh bag, like lingerie bag) to hold eating kit in
- Water bottle filled with potable water
- Backpacking style stove
- Stove gas & container for backpacking style stove
- Matches
- Fire starters (optional)
- Backpacking stove pot, for heating water for coffee, hot chocolate

## GROUP GEAR (if you have)

- Dining Fly
- Water container, one 1-gallon type collapsible plastic
- Supplies to make patrol flag

## PERSONAL GEAR

- Clothing (prepare for any weather)
- Hats, gloves (as appropriate)
- Hiking shoes
- Comfortable camp shoes
- Rain gear
- Flashlight with new/extra batteries
- Pocketknife
- Backpack with raincover
- Daypack/fannypack
- Sleeping bag, or two-three blankets
- Sleeping pad or ground cloth for under sleeping bag
- Sun protection; lip balm
- Compass
- Clean-up kit
  - Soap
  - Toothbrush and toothpaste
  - Dental floss





- Comb / brush
- Wash cloth
- Towel
- Shower shoes (flip-flops; optional)
- Personal first aid kit containing the 10 essentials:
  - Adhesive bandages (6)
  - Sterile gauze pads, 3-by-3 inch (2)
  - Adhesive tape (1 small roll)
  - Moleskin, 3-by-6 inch (1)
  - Soap (1 small bar)
  - Antiseptic (1 small tube)
  - Scissors (1 pair)
  - Latex gloves (1 pair)
  - Mouth-barrier device for rescue breathing or CPR (1)
  - Plastic goggles or other eye protection (1)



### **CLASS GEAR**

- Pencil/pen
- 3-ring binder at least 1" (for handouts)
- spare notebook paper for notetaking
- Scout Handbook for your age level (Boy Scout Handbook is a great resource regardless of unit type)
